- Most cases of asbestos are diagnosed 10 years or more after a person is exposed to the mineral. In some cases, the asbestos disease appears after 40 or 50 years.
- Asbestos-related disease has been diagnosed in veterans (particularly Navy veterans), trade workers who were exposed to asbestos dust on the job and people who lived with the workers.
- Approximately 3,000 people are diagnosed with mesothelioma each year in the U.S.
